

RAFFLE RULES

1. Organization & Registration

- The raffle is conducted by Ventura County Library Foundation an eligible California nonprofit organization with more than one year's operation.
- Registration number: RF0017153 issued by the California Department of Justice.
- Effective date of these rules: October 19, 2025.

2. Ticket Price & Sale

- Ticket price: \$5.00 for 1 ticket, \$20.00 for 5 tickets, \$50 for 15 tickets.
- Tickets are sold only in person at the Ventura Botanical Gardens.
- No online ticket sales are permitted (advertising online is allowed).
- Ticket price is not tax-deductible.

3. Eligibility & Restrictions

- Ticket purchasers must be at least 18 years old.
- Tickets are nontransferable and nonrefundable.
- Organization employees or persons with a financial interest may not participate.

4. Drawing & Winner Determination

- Winner(s) determined by random drawing of ticket stubs.
- Drawing will occur on October 19, 2025, Ventura Botanical Gardens at 4:00 pm, supervised by an adult.
- If unforeseen circumstances occur, drawing may be postponed with notice.
- Winner must present verification within 30 days to claim prize.

5. Prizes & Prize Claims

- Description of prize(s): Gift Cards / Coupons, Gift Baskets, Books, Household Goods
- Winner responsible for applicable taxes, and fees.
- Unclaimed prizes after 30 days will revert back to the Ventura County Library Foundation.

6. Use of Proceeds / Financial Disclosure

- At least 90% of gross receipts from ticket sales will be used for charitable purposes in California.
- Up to 10% may be used for administrative costs.
- Accurate records of income and expenditures will be maintained and reported.

7. Public Posting & Availability of Rules

- These rules will be posted at the event site and made available in print.
